LETTER FROM THE FOUNDERS

When we started Impact 100 Seattle a little more than a year ago, we knew we wanted to create a unique collective giving organization guided by the principles of Trust-Based Philanthropy. Of course, we never imagined the challenges that 2020 would bring.

In March, despite cancelling all recruitment events, we hit our goal of 100 members and \$100,000. We then quickly voted to expedite our grant process and pivot from one large grant to a few smaller ones. In June of 2020, just three months later, we awarded **unrestricted** grants to 5 transformational, community-based organizations. We hope to support their work throughout 2020 and beyond.

As we enter the second year of our existence, we have big plans to bring the ideas of trust-based philanthropy to more women in the Puget Sound Region. We hope to connect them with each other and small, community-based organizations that are serving this area. We hope you will join us on our journey as a member, a donor, or a partner.




PARTNER PERSPECTIVE
