Wilson, Chairman of the Committee for Local Arrangements for the Academy; the Tennessee Commissioner of Education, the Honorable Sam H. Ingram; and the Tennessee Commissioner of Finance and Administration, the Honorable William S. Jones."

All resolutions were accepted by a passed motion.

OTHER BUSINESS

1. President Mallette asked the Chairman of the Science Advisory Committee, Dr. William Ellis, to present the same report he gave the previous evening to the Executive Committee. Dr. Robert Sears moved that the committee be dissolved as recommended by Dr. Ellis. Dr. Benjamin Stone seconded the motion. After much discussion on the pros and cons of having such a committee, the motion to abolish the committee passed—33 aye, 8 nay, and 10 abstentions.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:45 p.m. E.S.T.
